



# Ruta de las Iglesias Fernandinas

The Cathedral Chapter of Cordoba, in its continuous commitment to the reassessment of our culture, encourages a new route throughout the Fernandine Churches. This monumental itinerary, which finds its point of reference in the main temple of the city, shall rediscover the interesting heritage legacy that Cordoba amasses.

The relevance of these temples, founded in the context of the conquest of Ferdinand III the Saint, King of Castile, is not only related to the uniqueness of its Medieval architecture but also in its function as a nucleus of the repopulation of urban life, through the organization into congregations. The Parish of Nuestra Señora del Carmen of Puerta Nueva is included, which contains a significant example of the Baroque painting of Juan de Valdés Leal, in addition to the Oath of Saint Raphael, the Church of San Pablo, and the Church of San Basilio.

We find ourselves in front of living buildings, which retain their liturgical function and have known how to collect their artistic contributions throughout the ages, until becoming the unique monuments that we enjoy today.
